Child Care During Worship For Ages 2-4 Years – We now offer child care for these ages during the 9:30 A.M. service. Children will be entertained by both a volunteer parent and 2-3 youth who are committing to help from our Prep 1 and 2 classes. Children who are younger than 2 will need to remain with their parent if the parent and child do find it necessary to step out of worship.
