To participate in an event you need to do one of the following:

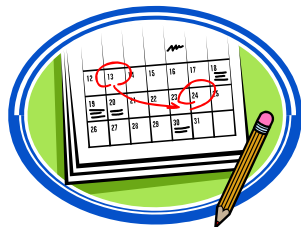

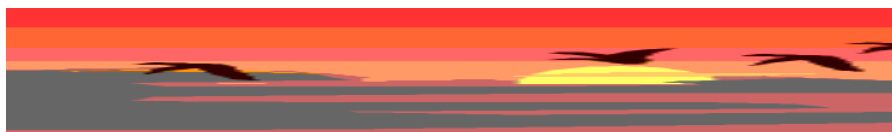
Think this over....
